Appointed to the post of the Secretary of State in the Ministry of Economy on March 7th, 2006.

Born on May 18th, 1969 in Warsaw.

1998 – he graduated from post-secondary School of Economics (financing and accountancy).

In years 1989 – 1994 he studied at the History Faculty at Warsaw University.

Since 2001 he has been a Member of Parliament. During the fifth term of parliamentary office, since November 2005, he has held the post of vice chairman in the Commission of the Treasury of State. Within his parliamentary activity, he is specialized in economical issues.

He actively supports democratic changes in Eastern Europe. He supervised presidential elections in Ukraine (2004), in Kazakhstan (2005), and parliamentary elections in Kyrgyzstan and Moldova (2005).

In years 1999 – 2001 he was the advisor to the Mazovian Province Governor. Till 2001 he run a family-owned business in trade and services. In years 1996 – 1997 he was a financial director in a consulting company. For the following two years he was a Sales Manager in a trade company.

In years 1998 - 2001 he was a councillor of the Central Municipal District of Warsaw, in years 2000 – 2001 he chaired the Auditing Committee.

For several years he has been actively acting in the ZHR (the Scouting Association of the Polish Republic), in years 1993 – 1995 he was a Scoutmaster of the ZHR Board of Central Warsaw.

In years 1996 – 2000 he was active in Ruch Stu (modern, right wing political movement of liberals and conservatives), in years 1998 – 2000 he was a member of National Board. Since 2002 he has been a member of PiS Party (Law and Justice).

He is interested in history of the 20th Century, in issues concerning local government, and in climbing. He is keen on sailing, and skiing. His favourite form of spending leisure time is to go to the Pieniny Mountains and Nidzica with his family.

He speaks English and Russian.
